

New Licence Certificates

In order to assist in providing improved services to riders, the Board and staff of Motorcycling Western Australia have introduced a new initiative to ensure once a licence application has been processed and posted technical problems outside of the control of Motorcycling Western Australia don't inconvenience members.

From 22 April 2010 Licence Certificates will be accepted by the Steward of the meeting as proof positive that the holder of the certificate is a valid licence holder.

This will mean that should you, having sent your application to the Motorcycling Western Australia office in time, and had it successfully processed, not received your plastic licence card in the mail, you will still be able to participate.

Naturally there are some conditions:

- Certificates will not be issued if you have not allowed enough time for staff to process applications. Applications need to be received 10 days prior to the expiry date. We won't issue certificates because 'I forgot to post my licence application' etc.
- The licence MUST have been already processed, with the delay either a technical issue in the office (ie the printer is out of service, or the internet is down), or an issue outside of the office (ie non-delivery by Australia Post).
- It is only valid for seven days from the date of issue.

To apply for a certificate, contact the office by phone. Having satisfied the conditions, a certificate will be either faxed or emailed.

At the event the following extra conditions need to be observed:

- The certificate has the same authority as a licence.
- The Steward needs to be contacted and a Licence Declaration completed
- The payment of the \$45 fee for a Licence Declaration DOES NOT apply.

A Licence Certificate is reproduced above for your information.
