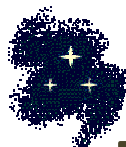


Track Closure

Calling Junior Parents at Coastal

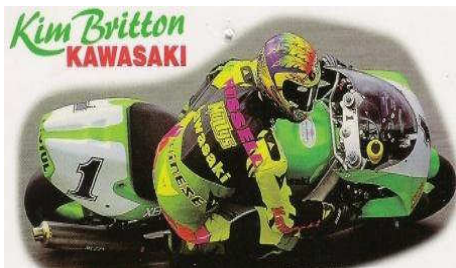
