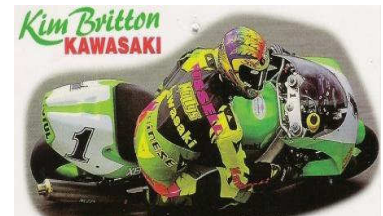

Coaching at Coastal

Coaching can now be carried out at Coastal Park on the following basis:

1. Saturday mornings up until 12.00pm will be set aside for coaching unless there is a scheduled busy bee, or we have work that needs to be carried out on the track.
2. Coaching can only be conducted by a qualified coach (Level 1 accredited and above).
3. The coaching must be booked one week in advance.
4. This coaching is not intended for groups or clinics, separate permission for these must be obtained through a General Meeting.
5. Riders need to be members of CMCC and need to have their own key to access the track. Normal sign on procedures still apply.
6. The track will not be open for general practice at this time.
